Summary

New Features

Many small to medium size new features have been introduced in this release to improve the user's efficiency when completing tasks in CAMIO. These appear in:

- Admin tool
- Asset Manager
- LUCI
- Media Engine

Improvements

This release contains some substantial platform level improvements that improve stability and scalability, building foundations to deliver future features in a robust way. These platform improvements include:

1. Changing the messaging platform to Rabbit MQ
2. Upgrading .Net to .Net 8.0
3. Introducing gRPC as the internal CAMIO API protocol

Upgrade path

CAMIO 5.5.2 is backwardly compatible with all CAMIO 4 & 5 versions.




Enable HTTPS Binding in Windows IIS

With CAMIO build 5.3 and onward several services are using HTTPS communications even if LUCI has been set to HTTP during the installation process. Therefore it is necessary to add the HTTPS Binding within IIS. To do so,

- Open Windows IIS Manager on the CAMIO Server
- Under Sites, right click on the Default Web Site and select “Edit Bindings...”
- If no “https” binding exists, click on Add...
- On the displayed window, select ‘https’ for the Type and ‘WMSVC-SHA2’ (or a valid certificate) for the SSL Certificate, then click OK and Close



If this configuration is not properly set, CAMIO Asset Manager should display an empty panel:




It is now possible to re-sync all replications via the Admin Tool \- Replication Management page. A Resync All button is now available which will resync all replications across all CAMIOs in the group.

It is now possible to all LUCI Autofills via the Admin Tool \- Replication Management page.






CAM-7084 Disk space indicator

Hovering over the **i** icon in the Asset Manager > Asset Manager left hand panel now shows a tooltip with used and available disk space.




CAM-7049 Hide all/Unhide all Button for Replaceables

Sports customers may have hundreds of replaceables per scene. Many of these may not be updateable in LUCI and can be hidden using the Replaceables tab in Asset Manager. This has now been made more efficient so that all replaceables can be set to hidden and only specific replaceables can then be made visible. This saves time when needing to hide all replaceables but can be used to view them all and remove only specific replaceables as well.




CAM-6556 Add a validation warning to Upload in Asset Manager

A warning message has been added in Asset Manager when unsupported file types are being uploaded. The user can ignore the warning and still upload the files if they wish, but they can't be used in the Camio workflow.




CAM-6334 Compose Tool availability even when linked to Axis

When CAMIO is linked to Axis, the Compose Image button used to link through to placing an order in Axis and the ability to compose an image was not available. This has now been changed so that the Compose Image button is always displayed regardless of whether the Axis option is available or not.



CAM-7365 Bring back custom data panels

Custom data panels have been reinstated with a new feature to be able to select a different sizing of the edit window when template is open.




CAM-7395 Consolidate logging throughout CAMIO

Log files in CAMIO have been largely consolidated with exceptions.


CAM-5481 Asset Manager - Disable Folder Deletion if not empty

In the Asset Manager folder tree, right-clicking and selecting Delete will now present a warning message if the folder is not empty. All files within the folder must be deleted before the folder can be deleted.




CAM-5739 Capability to name a Saved Item

The LUCI Save function now has an editable text field with the MOS Abstract (e.g. "TEST\00010045 (L3 Super)") as a default value




CAM-5650 Message when no Renderer is available or an error occurs

When trying a preview in LUCI, if no renderer is available or a rendering error occurs, a message is now displayed , so it is clear to users what the problem is.




CAM-5646 Saved Items - Delete button icon changed

In the Luci Saved Items tab, the Delete icon has been changed to a trashcan to be consistent with the rest of the UI.



CAM-5903 Sort Categories and Filters in alphabetical order

The Category and Filter lists were ordered by creation time. They are now sorted in alphabetical order to ease of use.



CAM-5907 Exclude Contexts names from the search

Context names are now excluded from search results in LUCI as too many, not relevant results were being returned.


CAM-6381 Adjust Spacing in LUCI UI to Utilize Space for Larger Previews

LUCI previously had up to three equally spaced columns, one for text, one for media, one for the preview. Now the text and media replaceable columns are sized to fit, leaving all the remaining space for the preview image.




CAM-6392 Rename the "Browse Templates" tab depending on the selected sub-menu

LUCI now gracefully handles the situation where MOS object files have been deleted from the file system

Media Engine

CAM-5657 Purge of the DataEngine jobs buckets

Preview and Render jobs stored in CAMIO DataEngine were immediately deleted when correctly executed, but stayed forever if not executed for any reason. The “Media Engine API Render Cleanup” scheduled job now includes the purge of the related DataEngine buckets.


